

# **JACKET • AMOROSO** Design 22 – Filati Journal 61



### Size 36 - 40 (42 - 46)

Instructions are given for smaller size. Figure in parenthesis refers to larger size. When only one figure is given, it applies to both sizes.

**Materials:** 400 (500) **g** of Lana Grossa **Amoroso** (23% pure wool, 23% silk, 23% cotton, 23% acrylic, 8% polyamide; 400 m/100 g) in Greige/Green Beige/Light Grey/Sand (col 1). Size 3.5 and 5 mm needles; size 3.5 mm circular needle, 120 cm long.

Selvage stitches: On every row: SI first st kwise, k last st.

**Charts A/B, C/D, E/F**: Numbers at left edge of charts indicate WS rows, numbers at right edge of charts indicate RS rows. Charts begin with a WS row. Work to patt rep, work 2 sts between arrows for patt rep, work to end of chart. Work rows 1 - 3 of chart A, C, E once, then rep rows 2 and 3. Rep rows 1 - 4 of chart B, D, F.

## St st: K on RS, p on WS.

**Full-fashion decrease (dbl decrease)**: <u>At beg of RS row</u>, selvage st, p1, sl 1 pwise wyib, p1, skp (sk2p); <u>at end of RS</u> <u>row</u>, work to last 6 (7) sts, k2tog (k3tog), p1, sl 1 pwise wyib, p1, selvage st – 1 (2) st(s) decreased at each edge. Next row (WS): Selvage st, k1, p1, k1, patt to last 4 sts, k1, p1, k1, selvage st.

**Gauge**: 20 sts and 30 rows =  $10 \times 10$  cm in chart patt B on size 5 mm needles.

**Back**: With size 3.5 mm needles cast on 111 (119) sts. Beg and end with a WS row, work chart A for 29 rows and piece meas 9 cm from cast-on. Change to size 5 mm needles. Work chart B for 90 rows = 30 cm. Next RS (raglan set-up) row: Work first st, M1L, work next st, M1L, work to last 2 sts, M1L, work next st, M1L, work last st = 115 (123) sts. Next row (WS): Selvage st, k1, p1, k1, patt to last 4 sts, k1, p1, k1, selvage st. Shape raglan: Working full-fashion dec, dec 1 st at each end of next 28 (32) RS rows, 2 sts at each end of next 4 RS rows. Work 1 WS row. Bind off rem 43 sts. **Pocket lining**: Make 2. With size 5 mm needles cast on 30 sts. Work in St st for 14 cm, ending with a RS row. Place sts on holder, cut yarn.

Left front: With size 3.5 mm needles cast on 52 (56) sts. Beg and end with a WS row, work chart C for 29 rows and piece meas 9 cm from cast-on. Change to size 5 mm needles. Work chart D for 32 rows = 10.5 cm. Next row (RS): Patt over first 8 (12) sts, work rib patt chart A over next 30 sts for pocket, patt to end. Work in patt as set by last row for a total of 8 rows = 3.5 cm. Next row (RS): Patt over first 8 (12) sts, bind off next 30 sts, patt to end. Next row (WS): Patt to bound-off sts, work 30 sts of lining into patt, patt to end. Cont in patt across all sts until chart D has been worked for a total of 76 rows = 25 cm. Shape neck: Next row RS (dec row): Patt to last 6 sts, k2tog or p2tog as needed for patt, work rem 4 sts. Rep dec row every 6th row 11 times, then every 4th row 1 time. At same time, when same length as back to raglan, work raglan set-up row and raglan shaping at right edge same as for back. Bind off rem 5 sts.


**Right front**: Work same as left front, reversing all shaping and working according to chart E/F.

**Sleeves**: With size 3.5 mm needles cast on 67 (75) sts. Beg and end with a WS row, work chart A for 35 rows and piece meas 11 cm from cast-on. Change to size 5 mm needles. Work chart B for 96 rows = 32 cm. Next RS (sleeve cap setup) row: Work first st, M1L, work next st, M1L, work to last 2 sts, M1L, work next st, M1L, work last st = 71 (79) sts. Next row (WS): Selvage st, k1, p1, k1, patt to last 4 sts, k1, p1, k1, selvage st. Shape sleeve cap: Working full-fashion dec, dec 1 st at each end of next 20 (24) RS rows, then every alt RS row 6 times. Work 1 WS row. Bind off rem 19 sts.


**Finishing**: Pin pieces to measurements and block. Sew raglan, side and sleeve seams. <u>Front and neckband</u>: With size 3.5 mm circular needle and RS facing, pick up and k 170 (178) sts along right front and top of right sleeve, 111 sts along back neck, 170 (178) sts along top of left sleeve and left front edge = 451 (467) sts. Beg and end with a WS row, work rib patt chart A for 21 rows = 7 cm. Bind off all sts in rib. Sew pocket linings in place on WS.


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
## Charts A/B, C/D, E/F

- $\triangle$  = sl 1 pwise wyib






## Gauge Swatch

### Before you begin ...

...make a gauge swatch. Use the recommended needles, yarns and pattern stitch for your gauge swatch. It should measure approx. 12 cm x 12 cm. Cast-on and bind-off rows, as well as selvage stitches should not be included in the measurement. Pin your swatch and block it as you would the finished pieces of the garment. Count stitches and rows over 10 cm. If your gauge swatch is too small, switch to larger needles. If your gauge swatch is too big, switch to smaller needles.
