

CROCHET BLANKET · RISERVA

Design 23 – Home 74



Size approx. 82 x 90 cm

Materials: 100 g of Lana Grossa Riserva (70% organic cotton, 30% recycled polyamide; 125 m/50 g) in White (col 1) and 50 g each in Grey Brown (col 4), Yellow (col 17), Ecru (col 2), Antique Pink (col 12), Midnight Blue (col 10), Red (col 15), Reed Green (col 19), Petrol (col 7) and Silver Grey (col 9). Size 5 mm crochet hook.

2-row pattern: Row 1: Ch 1, sc across row. Row 2: Ch 3 (counts as dc), dc across row.

Main patt: Work 2-row patt in colors as given. NOTE: Some rows are worked in more than one color.

Begin main patt: 2 rows (that is: 2-row patt) in Grey Brown. In Yellow: 1 row sc.

In Yellow/Ecru: 1 row dc = ch 3, 54 dc in Yellow, 74 dc in Ecru. 2 rows each in Antique Pink, Midnight Blue, Grey Brown, Red, Ecru, Reed Green, Yellow, Midnight Blue, Petrol, Antique Pink. In Silver Grey/Reed Green: 1 row sc: ch 1, 100 sc in Silver Grey, 29 sc in Reed Green.

In Reed Green: 1 row dc.

2 rows each in Grey Brown, Ecru, Yellow, Silver Grey, Red, Petrol, Reed Green, Midnight Blue, Antique Pink, Silver Grey, Ecru, Grey Brown, Petrol, Yellow, Red, Antique Pink, Silver Grey, Reed Green, Midnight Blue, Ecru, Petrol, Red, Grey Brown, Antique Pink, Reed Green, Yellow, Silver Grey, Midnight Blue, Petrol.

In Antique Pink: 1 row sc.

In Antique Pink/Grey Brown/Red: 1 row dc: ch 3, 65 dc in Antique Pink, 59 dc in Grey Brown, 4 dc in Red.

2 rows each in Red, Ecru, Reed Green, Silver Grey.

In Yellow: 1 row sc.

In Yellow/Midnight Blue: 1 row dc: ch 3, 79 dc in Yellow, 49 dc in Midnight Blue.

Gauge: 15 sts and 11 rows = 10×10 cm in 2-row patt with size 5 mm hook.


Blanket: With size 5 mm hook and White, ch 129. Work in main patt. Fasten off. <u>Edging</u>: With size 5 mm hook and White, work 1 rnd sc, then 1 rnd dc around entire edge of blanket, 3 sts in each corner. Fasten off.



Gauge Swatch

Before you begin ...

...make a gauge swatch. Use the recommended needles, yarns and pattern stitch for your gauge swatch. It should measure approx. 12 cm x 12 cm. Cast-on and bind-off rows, as well as selvage stitches should not be included in the measurement. Pin your swatch and block it as you would the finished pieces of the garment. Count stitches and rows over 10 cm. If your gauge swatch is too small, switch to larger needles. If your gauge swatch is too big, switch to smaller needles.



Abbreviations

beg = begin(ning) \cdot **ch** = chain \cdot **cont** = continue \cdot **dec** = decreas(e)(ing) \cdot **inc** = increas(e)(ing) \cdot **k** = knit \cdot **kwise** = as if to knit **meas** = measures \cdot **M1L** = lift strand between sts from front to back and knit this strand through the back loop \cdot **M1R** = lift strand between sts from the back and knit this strand through the front loop \cdot **patt** = pattern \cdot **pm** = place marker \cdot **p** = purl **pwise** = as if to purl \cdot **rem** = remain(ing) \cdot **rep** = repeat(s) \cdot **rev St st** = reverse stockinette stitch \cdot **rnd(s)** = round(s) \cdot **RS** = right side \cdot **sc** = single crochet \cdot **skp** = slip 1 stitch as if to knit, knit 1 stitch, pass slipped stitch over knitted stitch \cdot **sk2p** = slip 1 stitch as if to knit, knit 2 together, pass slipped stitch over knitted stitch \cdot **s2kp** = slip 2 stitches as if to knit, k 1 stitch, pass slipped stitches over knitted stitch \cdot **s1** = slip \cdot **st(s)** = stitch(es) \cdot **St st** = stockinette stitch \cdot **tbl** = through the back loop \cdot **tog** = together \cdot **wyib** = with yarn in back of work \cdot **wyif** = with yarn in front of work \cdot **WS** = wrong side \cdot **yo(s)** = yarn over(s)
