Design 19 – Gomitolo 09

CROCHET HEADSCARF GOMITOLO SELEZIONE 2

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
Size approx. 58 x 25 cm

Materials: 100 g of Lana Grossa Gomitolo Selezione 2 (75% cotton, 25% viscose; 260 m/100 g) in Mint/Ochre/Lilac/Grey Beige/Light Green/Orange/Cognac (col 2004). Size 4 mm crochet hook.

Crochet patt: Work according to chart. Numbers at right and left edge of chart indicate rows. Chart begins with ch 4, 2 dc in 4th ch from hook. Beg on row 2, work dc into ch-sp on row below.

Gauge: 17 sts and 10 rows = $10 \times 10 \text{ cm}$ in crochet patt with size 4 mm hook.

Headscarf: Using size 4 mm hook, ch 4. Work chart rows 1 – 26 once. At end of row 26, ch 40, turn. Next row: Ch 1, sc in each of next 40 ch, sl st in each last row st, ch 40, turn. Next row: Ch 1, sc in each of next 40 ch. Fasten off.






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Gauge Swatch

Before you begin ...

...make a gauge swatch. Use the recommended needles, yarns and pattern stitch for your gauge swatch. It should measure approx. 12 cm x 12 cm. Cast-on and bind-off rows, as well as selvage stitches should not be included in the measurement. Pin your swatch and block it as you would the finished pieces of the garment. Count stitches and rows over 10 cm. If your gauge swatch is too small, switch to larger needles. If your gauge swatch is too big, switch to smaller needles.
