### Design 24 – Gomitolo 09



Size approx. 38 x 40 cm

Materials: 200 g each of Lana Grossa Gomitolo Selezione 1 (80% cotton, 10% viscose, 10% acrylic; 290 m/100 g) in Light Green/Yellow/Emerald/Olive/Grey/Orange/Moss/Dark Green (col 1003) and Violet/Lilac/Natural/Grey Yellow/Yolk/Vanilla/Burgundy (col 1006). Size 3.5 mm crochet hook.

**Tip**: If you prefer to crochet the shopper in one color, you will need just under 300 g = 3 balls.

**Double crochet [dc] in rows**: Beg each row with ch 2 (counts as dc). Change color every other row.

**Gauge**: 20 dc and 10 rows =  $10 \times 10 \text{ cm}$  with size 3.5 mm hook.

**Shopper**: First piece: Using size 3.5 mm hook, ch 76. Work dc in rows for 40 cm. Fasten off. Repeat for second piece.

**Straps**: Make 2. Using size 3.5 mm hook, ch 10. Work dc in rows for 74 cm. Fasten off.

**Finishing**: Sew 1 strap to top edge of each piece, approx. 7 cm in from center. Sew 2 pieces of shopper tog. <u>Fringe</u>: Cut 20 strands of yarn, each strand approx. 18 cm long. Attach 10 fringe evenly spaced along each side edge.

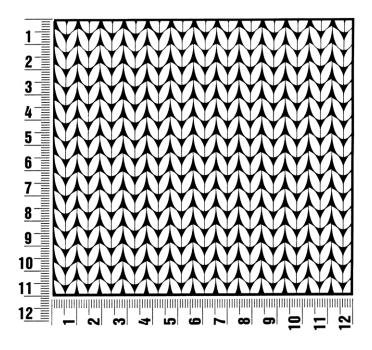


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#### Gauge Swatch

#### Before you begin ...

...make a gauge swatch. Use the recommended needles, yarns and pattern stitch for your gauge swatch. It should measure approx. 12 cm x 12 cm. Cast-on and bind-off rows, as well as selvage stitches should not be included in the measurement. Pin your swatch and block it as you would the finished pieces of the garment. Count stitches and rows over 10 cm. If your gauge swatch is too small, switch to larger needles. If your gauge swatch is too big, switch to smaller needles.
