LANA GROSSA



Design 20 – Tücher & Co. 06

SCARF PIÙ BELLA

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Size approx. 34 x 188 cm

Materials: 150 g of Lana Grossa **Più Bella** (59% baby alpaca, 20% polyamide, 15% cashmere, 6% Merino wool; 100 m/25 g) in Pink **(col 4)**. Size 6 mm needles; size 5 mm crochet hook.

Main patt: Multiple of 4 + 3 + 4 selvage sts. <u>Row 1</u>: Two-stitch selvage, k3, * (k3tog, yo, k3tog) into same 3 sts tog, k1; rep from * to last 2 sts, two-stitch selvage. <u>Rows 2 and 4</u>: Purl all sts and yos between two-stitch selvage. <u>Row 5</u>: Two-stitch selvage, k1, * (k3tog, yo, k3tog) into same 3 sts tog, k1; rep from * to last 4 sts, k2, two-stitch selvage. Rep rows 1 – 4.


Crochet border: Multiple of 6+3+3. Work according to chart. Numbers at right edge of chart indicate RS rows, numbers at left edge of chart indicate WS rows. Work rows 1-3 once, then rep rows 2 and 3.

Two-stitch selvage: On RS row, sl 1 pwise wyib, k1, patt to last 2 sts, k1, sl 1 pwise wyib. On WS row, p1, sl 1 pwise wyif, patt to last 2 sts, sl 1 pwise wyif, p1.

Gauges: 18 sts and 16 rows = $10 \times 10 \text{ cm}$ in main patt on size 6 mm needles; 18 sts and 6 rows = $10 \times 10 \text{ cm}$ in crochet border patt with size 5 mm hook.

Scarf: With size 6 mm needles cast on 63 sts. Purl 1 WS row. Work main patt for 140 cm, working patt rep between *'s 14 times across row. Bind off all sts. <u>Crochet border</u>: Using crochet hook and with RS facing, sl st-join yarn to bound-off edge. Ch 3, work row 1 of chart = work patt rep 9 times, work to end of chart = 10 patt reps total. Cont to foll chart, work rows 1 – 3 once, then work rows [2 and 3] 5 times. Fasten off. Work crochet border in same way along cast-on edge.

Finishing: Pin piece to measurements and block.



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


Chart key:

- = chain (ch)
- = single crochet (sc)
- † = double crochet (dc)
- = bobble: [yo, insert hook and pull up long loop] 3 times into same st, wrap yarn and draw through all loops on hook, except last one, wrap yarn and draw through rem 2 loops



= 3 bobbles in same st or sp: [bobble in next st or sp, ch 3] 2 times, bobble in next st or sp




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Gauge Swatch

Before you begin ...

...make a gauge swatch. Use the recommended needles, yarns and pattern stitch for your gauge swatch. It should measure approx. 12 cm x 12 cm. Cast-on and bind-off rows, as well as selvage stitches should not be included in the measurement. Pin your swatch and block it as you would the finished pieces of the garment. Count stitches and rows over 10 cm. If your gauge swatch is too small, switch to larger needles. If your gauge swatch is too big, switch to smaller needles.
