PULLOVER NASTRINO

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Size 36/38 (40/42, 44/46)

Instructions are given for first size. Figures in parenthesis refer to larger sizes. When only one figure is given, it applies to all sizes.

Materials: 250 (250, 300) g of Lana Grossa Nastrino (100% cotton; 190 m/50 g) in Broom Yellow (col 11). Size 3.5 mm needles; size 3.5 mm circular needle, 50 cm long.

Selvage sts: On every row: Knit first and last st.

Main patt: Even number of sts. Row 1 (RS): Selvage st, * yo, k1; rep from *, end selvage st. Row 2 (WS): Selvage st, * sl 2 sts to right needle, dropping yos and pulling sts up to elongate, sl 2 sts back to left needle; insert right needle from right to left into first st, knit 2nd st, then knit first st; rep from *, end selvage st. Row 3 (RS): Knit all sts. Row 4 (WS): As row 3. Row 5 (RS): As row 1. Row 6 (WS): Selvage st, sl 1 st to right needle, dropping yo and pulling st up to elongate, sl st back to left needle, k1; * sl 2 sts to right needle, dropping yos and pulling sts up to elongate, sl 2 sts back to left needle; insert right needle from right to left into first st, knit 2nd st, then knit first st; rep from * to last 2 sts, sl 1 st to right needle, dropping yo and pulling st up to elongate, sl st back to left needle, k1, selvage st. Row 7 (RS): As row 3. Row 8 (WS): As row 3. Rep rows 1 – 8 for main patt. Note: When working shaping, make sure to stay in patt.


Gauge: 20 sts and 27 rows = 10×10 cm in main patt on size 3.5 mm needles.

Back: With size 3.5 mm needles cast on 102 (108, 116) sts. Knit 1 WS row. Work in main patt and shape sides as foll: Dec 1 st at each end of 17th row, then every 18th row 4 times = 92 (98, 106) sts. Work even until a total of 108 rows has been worked in main patt and piece meas 40 cm from cast-on. Shape armholes: Bind off 4 sts at beg of next 2 rows, 2 sts at beg of next 2 rows, 1 st at beg of next 8 rows = 72 (78, 86) sts. Work even until a total of 52 (54, 56) rows has been worked from beg of armhole shaping and armhole meas 19 (20, 21) cm. Shape shoulders and neck: At each shoulder edge bind off 6 (7,9) sts 3 times. <u>At same time</u>, on first row of shoulder shaping, shape neck as foll: Bind off center 26 sts. Working each side separately, bind off 5 sts at each neck edge 1 time. No sts rem.

Front: Work same as back until a total of 44 (46, 48) rows has been worked from beg of armhole shaping and armhole meas 16 (17, 18) cm. Shape neck: Next row (RS): Bind off center 6 sts. Working each side separately, bind off 3 sts at each neck edge 5 times and when same length as back to shoulders, shape shoulders same as for back. No sts rem.

Sleeves: With size 3.5 mm needles cast on 62 (64, 66) sts. Knit 1 WS row. Work in main patt and shape sleeve as foll: Inc 1 st at each end of 29th row, then every 8 (8, 6)th row 4 (5, 6) times = 72 (76, 80) sts. Work increased sts into patt. Work even until a total of 74 rows has been worked in main patt and piece meas 28 cm from cast-on. Shape sleeve cap: Bind off 4 sts at beg of next 2 rows, 2 sts at beg of next 2 rows, 1 st at beg of next 28 (32, 34) rows, 2 sts at beg of next 2 rows, 3 sts at beg of next 2 rows, 4 sts at beg of next 2 rows. Bind off rem 14 (14, 16) sts.

Finishing: Pin pieces to measurements and block. Sew shoulder seams. <u>Neckband</u>: With size 3.5 mm circular needle, pick up and k 96 sts evenly around neck edge. Place beg of rnd marker and join for working in rnds. Knit 1 rnd. Bind off all sts pwise. Sew in sleeves. Sew side and sleeve seams.






Gauge Swatch

Before you begin ...

...make a gauge swatch. Use the recommended needles, yarns and pattern stitch for your gauge swatch. It should measure approx. 12 cm x 12 cm. Cast-on and bind-off rows, as well as selvage stitches should not be included in the measurement. Pin your swatch and block it as you would the finished pieces of the garment. Count stitches and rows over 10 cm. If your gauge swatch is too small, switch to larger needles. If your gauge swatch is too big, switch to smaller needles.

beg = begin(ning) \cdot **ch** = chain \cdot **cont** = continue \cdot **dec** = decreas(e)(ing) \cdot **inc** = increas(e)(ing) \cdot **k** = knit \cdot **kwise** = as if to knit **meas** = measures \cdot **M1L** = lift strand between sts from front to back and knit this strand through the back loop \cdot **M1R** = lift strand between sts from the back and knit this strand through the front loop \cdot **patt** = pattern \cdot **pm** = place marker \cdot **p** = purl **pwise** = as if to purl \cdot **rem** = remain(ing) \cdot **rep** = repeat(s) \cdot **rev** St st = reverse stockinette stitch \cdot **rnd(s)** = round(s) \cdot **RS** = right side \cdot **sc** = single crochet \cdot **skp** = slip 1 stitch as if to knit, knit 1 stitch, pass slipped stitch over knitted stitch \cdot **sk2p** = slip 1 stitch as if to knit, knit 2 together, pass slipped stitch over knitted stitch \cdot **s2kp** = slip 2 stitches as if to knit, k 1 stitch, pass slipped stitches over knitted stitch \cdot **sl** = slip \cdot **st(s)** = stitch(es) \cdot St st = stockinette stitch \cdot **tbl** = through the back loop \cdot **tog** = together \cdot **wyib** = with yarn in back of work \cdot **wyif** = with yarn in front of work \cdot **WS** = wrong side \cdot **yo(s)** = yarn over(s)
