# **PULLOVER · ALTA MODA COTOLANA** Design 21 – Classici 26



#### Size 36/38 (40/42, 44)

Instructions are given for first size. Figures in parenthesis refer to larger sizes. When only one figure is given, it applies to all sizes.

Materials: 400 (450, 500) g of Lana Grossa Alta Moda Cotolana (45% Merino wool, 45% Pima cotton, 10% polyamide; 150 m/50 g) in Coral (col 52). Size 4.5 mm needles; size 4 mm crochet hook.

St st: K on RS, p on WS.

Garter st: K every row.

**Chart patt**: Multiple of 13. Numbers at right edge of chart indicate RS rows, numbers at left edge of chart indicate WS rows. Rep rows 1 - 8. <u>Note</u>: St count varies from row to row.

Selvage sts: On every row: Knit first and last st.

**Two-stitch selvage**: <u>On RS row</u>, sl 1 pwise wyib, k1, patt to last 2 sts, k1, sl 1 pwise wyib. <u>On WS row</u>, p1, sl 1 pwise wyif, patt to last 2 sts, sl 1 pwise wyif, p1.

**Full-fashion decrease**: <u>At beg of RS row</u>, two-stitch selvage, k2, k2tog; <u>at end of RS row</u>, work to last 6 sts, skp, k2, two-stitch selvage.

**Full-fashion increase**: <u>On RS row</u>: M1R, 1 st in from each edge.

**Gauges**: On size 4.5 mm needles: 23 sts and 34 rows =  $10 \times 10$  cm in St st; 20 sts and 36 rows =  $10 \times 10$  cm in chart patt.

**Back**: With size 4.5 mm needles cast on 119 (125, 136) sts. Beg and end with a WS row work in garter st for 5 rows. Next row (RS): Selvage st, 0 (3, 2) sts in St st; work row 1 of chart, working patt rep 9 (9, 10) times; 0 (3, 2) sts in St st, selvage st. Cont in patt as set by last row, work chart rows 1 - 8 three times. Maintaining selvage sts, work in St st across all sts until piece meas 28 cm from cast-on, decreasing 2 (0, 1) st(s) on first row = 117 (125, 135) sts. Place marker in first and last st on last WS row to indicate beg of armholes. Shape armholes: Working full-fashion inc, inc 1 st at each end of next RS row, then every 14th row 4 times = 127 (135, 145) sts. Work even until armhole meas 19 (20, 21) cm, ending with a WS row. Shape shoulders: At each shoulder edge bind off 4 sts 6 times, 5 sts 3 times (4 sts 2 times, 5 sts 7 times / 5 sts 6 times, 6 sts 3 times). Bind off rem 49 sts.

**Front**: Work same as back to armholes. Shape armholes same as for back. <u>At same time</u>, when piece meas 30 (31, 32) cm from cast-on, shape V-neck as foll: Next row (RS): Bind off center st. Working each side separately and working full-fashion dec, dec 1 st at each neck edge every RS row 24 times and when same length as back to shoulders, shape shoulders same as for back. No sts rem.

**Sleeves**: With size 4.5 mm needles cast on 93 (93, 106) sts. Beg and end with a WS row work in garter st for 5 rows. Next row (RS): Selvage st; work row 1 of chart, working patt rep 7 (7, 8) times; selvage st. Cont in patt as set by last row, work chart rows 1 - 8 five times. Maintaining selvage sts, work in St st across all sts until piece meas 48 cm from cast-on, dec 0 (inc 6 / dec 1) st(s) on first row = 93 (99, 105) sts. Bind off all sts.

**Finishing**: Pin pieces to measurements and block. Sew shoulder seams. Using size 4 mm crochet hook work 1 row sl st along back neck edge. Sew on sleeves between markers. Sew side and sleeve seams.

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



Chart key:

- skp: sl 1 kwise, k1, pass slipped st over knitted st






## Gauge Swatch

### Before you begin ...

...make a gauge swatch. Use the recommended needles, yarns and pattern stitch for your gauge swatch. It should measure approx. 12 cm x 12 cm. Cast-on and bind-off rows, as well as selvage stitches should not be included in the measurement. Pin your swatch and block it as you would the finished pieces of the garment. Count stitches and rows over 10 cm. If your gauge swatch is too small, switch to larger needles. If your gauge swatch is too big, switch to smaller needles.

**beg** = begin(ning)  $\cdot$  **ch** = chain  $\cdot$  **cont** = continue  $\cdot$  **dec** = decreas(e)(ing)  $\cdot$  **inc** = increas(e)(ing)  $\cdot$  **k** = knit  $\cdot$  **kwise** = as if to knit **meas** = measures  $\cdot$  **M1L** = lift strand between sts from front to back and knit this strand through the back loop  $\cdot$  **M1R** = lift strand between sts from the back and knit this strand through the front loop  $\cdot$  **patt** = pattern  $\cdot$  **pm** = place marker  $\cdot$  **p** = purl **pwise** = as if to purl  $\cdot$  **rem** = remain(ing)  $\cdot$  **rep** = repeat(s)  $\cdot$  **rev** St st = reverse stockinette stitch  $\cdot$  **rnd(s)** = round(s)  $\cdot$  **RS** = right side  $\cdot$  **sc** = single crochet  $\cdot$  **skp** = slip 1 stitch as if to knit, knit 1 stitch, pass slipped stitch over knitted stitch  $\cdot$  **sk2p** = slip 1 stitch as if to knit, knit 2 together, pass slipped stitch over knitted stitch  $\cdot$  **s2kp** = slip 2 stitches as if to knit, k 1 stitch, pass slipped stitches over knitted stitch  $\cdot$  **sl** = slip  $\cdot$  **st(s)** = stitch(es)  $\cdot$  St st = stockinette stitch  $\cdot$  **tbl** = through the back loop  $\cdot$  **tog** = together  $\cdot$  **wyib** = with yarn in back of work  $\cdot$  **wyif** = with yarn in front of work  $\cdot$  **WS** = wrong side  $\cdot$  **yo(s)** = yarn over(s)
