

PULLOVER · CASHMERE 16 FINE

Design 04 - Classici 21



Size 36/38 (40/42, 44)

Instructions are given for first size. Figures in parenthesis refer to larger sizes. When only one figure is given, it applies to all sizes.

Materials: 300 (300, 350) g of Lana Grossa Cashmere 16 Fine (80% Merino wool, 10% cashmere, 10% polyamide; 320 m/50 g) in Light Grey (col 15). Size 5 mm needles; size 5 mm circular needle, 40 cm long; cable needle [cn].

Brioche rib in rows: Multiple of 2 + 1 + 2 selvage sts. **Row 1 (WS)**: Twisted garter selvage, * p1, k1; rep from * to last 2 sts, p1, twisted garter selvage. **Row 2 (RS)**: Twisted garter selvage, * k1; make a yo, then sl next st pwise; rep from * to last 2 sts, k1, twisted garter selvage. **Row 3 (WS)**: Twisted garter selvage, * make a yo, then sl next st pwise; ktog slipped st with its yo; rep from * to last 2 sts, make a yo, then sl next st pwise; twisted garter selvage. **Row 4 (RS)**: Twisted garter selvage, * ktog slipped st with its yo; make a yo, then sl next st pwise; rep from * to last 2 sts, ktog slipped st with its yo; twisted garter selvage. Work rows 1 – 4 once, then rep rows 3 and 4. **Note**: 1 stitch and 1 yo are treated as 1 stitch.

Brioche rib in rnds: Rnd 1: * K1, p1; rep from * around. **Rnd 2**: * Make a yo, then sl next st pwise; p1; rep from * around. **Rnd 3**: * Ktog slipped st with its yo; make a yo, then sl next st pwise; rep from * around. **Rnd 4**: * Make a yo, then sl next st pwise; ptog slipped st with its yo; rep from * around. Work rnds 1 – 4 once, then rep rnds 3 and 4. **Note**: 1 stitch and 1 yo are treated as 1 stitch.

Slip st rib: Odd number of sts. **Row 1 (WS)**: * P1, k1; rep from *, end p1. **Row 2 (RS)**: * K1, sl 1 pwise wyif; rep from *, end k1. **Row 3 (WS)**: * Sl 1 pwise wyif, k1; rep from *, end sl 1 pwise wyif. Work rows 1 – 3 once, then rep rows 2 and 3.

Twisted garter selvage: On RS row, ktbl first st, sl last st pwise wyib. On WS row, ptbl first st, sl last st pwise wyif.

St st: K on RS, p on WS.
Rev St st: P on RS, k on WS.

7-st center rib detail: 2 sts in rev St st, 3 sts in St st, 2 sts in rev St st.

4-st cable: Work according to chart 1 or 2 as given in instructions. Numbers at right edge of charts indicate RS rows; on WS rows purl all sts. Rep rows 1 – 6. Cable 1 is worked at the right edge with the full-fashion increase 1, cable 2 at the left edge with the full-fashion increase 2

Two-stitch selvage: On RS row, sl 1 pwise wyib, k1, patt to last 2 sts, k1, sl 1 pwise wyib. On WS row, p1, sl 1 pwise wyif, patt to last 2 sts, sl 1 pwise wyif, p1.

Full-fashion dbl decrease: At beg of RS row, two-stitch selvage, cable chart 1, 1 st in rev St st, k3tog; at end of RS row, work to last 10 sts, sk2p, 1 st in rev St st, cable chart 2, two-stitch selvage.

Full-fashion increase 1: On RS row: M1R, 11 sts in from each edge.

Full-fashion increase 2: On RS row: M1R, 2 sts in from each edge.

Gauges: On size 5 mm needles: 23 sts and 39 rows = 10 x 10 cm in St st; 21 sts and 58 rows = 10 x 10 cm in brioche rib; 11 sts in slip st rib = 2.5 cm wide.

Back: With size 5 mm needles cast on 113 (121, 131) sts. Next row (WS): Work slip st rib over first 11 sts; omitting selvage sts, work brioche rib over next 91 (99, 109) sts, work slip st rib over last 11 sts. Cont in patt as set by last row and shape sides as foll: Working full-fashion inc 1, inc 1 st at each end of 4th row from cast-on, then every foll 4th row 19 times = 153 (161, 171) sts. Work increased sts into brioche rib. Work even in patt until piece meas 14 cm from cast-on, ending with a WS row. Next RS (dec) row: Selvage st (k on RS, p on WS), k2tog 5 times, work next 63 (67, 72) sts in St st, work next 2 sts in rev St st, k1fbf into next st, work next 2 sts in rev St st, work next 63 (67, 72) sts in St st, k2tog 5 times, selvage st (k on RS, p on WS) = 145 (153, 163) sts. Maintaining selvage sts, working center rib detail over center 7 sts and rem sts in St st, cont until piece meas 37 cm from cast-on. Place marker in first and last st on last WS row to indicate beg of armholes and at same time, inc 1 st at each end of row = 147 (155, 165) sts. Working a two-stitch selvage at each edge and rem sts as established, cont until piece meas 17 (18, 19) cm from armhole markers, ending with a WS row. Shape shoulders and neck: At each shoulder edge bind off 6 (6, 7) sts 1 time, then 6 sts 4 times, 7 sts 3 times (then 7 sts 7 times / then 7 sts 3 times, 8 sts 4 times). At same time, when piece meas 2 cm from beg of shoulder shaping, shape neck as foll: Next row (RS): Bind off center 35 sts. Working each side separately, bind off 2 sts at each neck edge 2 times, 1 st 1 time. No sts rem.

Front: Work same as back until piece meas 50 (51, 52) cm from cast-on, ending with a WS row. Shape neck: Next row (RS): Bind off center 27 sts. Working each side separately, bind off 2 sts at each neck edge 2 times, 1 st 3 times, then 1 st every 4th row 2 times and when same length as back to shoulders, shape shoulders same as for back. No sts rem.

Sleeves: With size 5 mm needles cast on 59 sts. Work in brioche rib until piece meas 12 cm from cast-on, ending with a WS row. Next row (RS): Selvage st (k on RS, p on WS), work next 26 sts in St st, work next 2 sts in rev St st, k1fbf into next st, work next 2 sts in rev St st, work next 26 sts in St st, selvage st (k on RS, p on WS) = 62 sts. Maintaining selvage sts, work center rib detail over center 7 sts, rem sts in St st and shape sleeve as foll: Working full-fashion inc 2, inc 1 st at each end of 11 (9, 9)th row from end of brioche rib, then every 10th row 2 times, then every 8th row 6 times (then every alt 6th and 8th row 10 times / then every 6th row 12 times) = 80 (84, 88) sts. Work increased sts in St st. Work even until piece meas 34 cm from cast-on, inc 1 st at each end of last WS row = 82 (86, 90) sts. Working full-fashion dbl dec, dec 2 sts at each

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

end of next RS row, then every alt RS row 13 times (then every alt RS row 12 times, then every foll RS row 2 times / then every alt RS row 11 times, then every foll RS row 4 times) = 26 sts. Work 1 WS row. Bind off all sts.

Finishing: Pin pieces to measurements and block. Sew shoulder seams. **Neckband**: With size 5 mm circular needle,

pick up and k 94 sts evenly around neck edge. Place beg of rnd marker and join for working in rnds. Work brioche rib in rnds for 2 cm. Bind off all sts in patt. Sew on sleeves between markers. Sew side and sleeve seams, leaving bottom 14 cm of side seams open for split hem. NOTE: Sew all seams 1 st in from edge.







Chart key:

= sl 2 sts to cn and hold in front of work, k2,

then k2 from cn

= sl 2 sts to cn and hold in back of work, k2, then k2 from cn






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Gauge Swatch

Before you begin ...

...make a gauge swatch. Use the recommended needles, yarns and pattern stitch for your gauge swatch. It should measure approx. 12 cm x 12 cm. Cast-on and bind-off rows, as well as selvage stitches should not be included in the measurement. Pin your swatch and block it as you would the finished pieces of the garment. Count stitches and rows over 10 cm. If your gauge swatch is too small, switch to larger needles. If your gauge swatch is too big, switch to smaller needles.



Abbreviations

beg = begin(ning) \cdot **ch** = chain \cdot **cont** = continue \cdot **dec** = decreas(e)(ing) \cdot **inc** = increas(e)(ing) \cdot **k** = knit \cdot **kwise** = as if to knit **meas** = measures \cdot **M1L** = lift strand between sts from front to back and knit this strand through the back loop \cdot **M1R** = lift strand between sts from the back and knit this strand through the front loop \cdot **patt** = pattern \cdot **pm** = place marker \cdot **p** = purl **pwise** = as if to purl \cdot **rem** = remain(ing) \cdot **rep** = repeat(s) \cdot **rev St st** = reverse stockinette stitch \cdot **rnd(s)** = round(s) \cdot **RS** = right side \cdot **sc** = single crochet \cdot **skp** = slip 1 stitch as if to knit, knit 1 stitch, pass slipped stitch over knitted stitch \cdot **sk2p** = slip 1 stitch as if to knit, knit 2 together, pass slipped stitch over knitted stitch \cdot **s2kp** = slip 2 stitches as if to knit, k 1 stitch, pass slipped stitches over knitted stitch \cdot **s1** = slip \cdot **st(s)** = stitch(es) \cdot **St st** = stockinette stitch \cdot **tbl** = through the back loop \cdot **tog** = together \cdot **wyib** = with yarn in back of work \cdot **wyif** = with yarn in front of work \cdot **WS** = wrong side \cdot **yo(s)** = yarn over(s)
