PULLOVER

Size 36/38, 40/42 and 44

Instructions are given for first size. Figures in parenthesis refer to larger sizes. When only one figure is given, it applies to all sizes.

Material: Lana Grossa **Merino Superiore** (100% virgin wool (Merino extrafine), RL 180 m/50 g), **400 (450 - 500)** g Azure **(col 23)**; Size 3 and 3.5 mm needles, 1 size 3 circular needle, 40 cm long

Rib patt: k1, p1, alt.

St st: k on RS, p on WS, k in rds.

Garter selvage: On every row: K first and last st

Full-fashion increase: On RS row: M1R, 2 sts in from each edge. **Gauge:** St. St. with size 3.5 needle; 26 sts and 37 rows = 10 x 10 cm

Back: Cast on 148 (158 – 168) sts over 2 size 3 needles. Slip one needle tip out of the sts and work 1 row WS in rib. Knit selvage stitch as garter selv. Work St st for 7 cm, then 1 row from the back in rib and 1 row RS. Continue in St st with size 3.5 needles. For the side shape inc on both sides the following 9th row 1x 1 st, then in every 10th row 8x 1 st, working full-fashion increases = 166 (176 – 186) sts. Mark the beginning of the armholes on both sides at a total height of 33 cm. When the armhole is 19 (20 – 21) cm high, bind off on both sides for shoulder shape 1x 6 (7 – 7) sts, then in every 2nd row 3x 6 sts and 4x 7 sts (in every 2nd row 6x 7 sts and 1x 8 sts – in every 2nd row 1x 7 sts and 6x 8 sts). At a total height of 54 (55 – 56) cm cast off the middle 42 sts for the neckline, then in every 2nd row dec 1x 4 sts, 1x 3 sts, 1x 2 sts and 1x 1 stitch.

Front: Basically work like back. At a total height of 50 (51 - 52) cm cast off the middle 10 sts for the neckline, then in every 2nd row dec. 3x 4 sts, 2x 3 sts, 3x 2 sts and 2x 1 st.


Sleeves: Cast on 84 sts over 2 size 3 needle tips. Slip 1 needle tip from sts and knit 1 row in rib. Knit garter selv, for 7 cm St st, then WS 1 row rib and RS 1 row k. Cont St st with size 3.5 needles. For the sleeve shape, inc on both sides in the 15th

(13th - 11th) row, 1x 1 st, then in every 16th row 7x 1 st (alt. in every 12th and 14th row 9x 1 st - alt. every 10th and 12th row 11x 1 st), work full-fashion increases arb. = 100 (104 - 108) sts. Bind off all sts when piece meas 45 cm. Work 2nd sleeve in the same way.

Collar: Cast on 130 sts with size 3 circular needle. Close the work to round and mark the beginning of the round. Work 1 rd in rib, then 3 cm St st and 1 rd rib. Cast off sts loosely as they appear.

Finishing: Clamp parts, moisten and let dry.

Close shoulder seams. Sew in collar at the cast-off edge in the neckline. Sew on the sleeves 19 (20 – 21) cm on each side of the shoulder seam. Close side and sleeve seams.



GAUGE SWATCH

Before you begin knitting...

...make a gauge swatch. Use the recommended needles, yarns and pattern stitch for your gauge swatch. It should measure approx. 12 cm x 12 cm. Cast on and bind off rows, as well as selvage stitches should not be included in the measurement. Pin your swatch and block it as you would the finished pieces of the garment. Count stitches and rows over 10 cm. If your gauge swatch is too small, switch to larger needles. If your gauge swatch is too big, switch to smaller needles.
