

## PULLOVER · ALTA MODA CASHMERE 16

### Design 26 - Classici 21



**Size** 36/38 (40/42, 44)

Instructions are given for first size. Figures in parenthesis refer to larger sizes. When only one figure is given, it applies to all sizes.

Materials: 550 (600, 650) g of Lana Grossa Alta Moda Cashmere 16 (78% Merino wool, 12% cashmere, 10% polyamide; 110 m/50 g) in Mocha (col 47). Size 6 and 8 mm needles; size 6 mm circular needle, 40 cm long; one 30-cm long zipper in dark brown.

Rib patt: K1, p1.

St st: K on RS, p on WS.

**Two-stitch selvage**: On RS row, sl 1 pwise wyib, k1, patt to last 2 sts, k1, sl 1 pwise wyib. On WS row, p1, sl 1 pwise wyif, patt to last 2 sts, sl 1 pwise wyif, p1.

**Selvage st**: On RS row, ktbl first st, sl last st pwise wyib. On WS row, ptbl first st, sl last st pwise wyif.

**Full-fashion dbl decrease**: At beg of RS row, selvage st, k2, sk2p; at end of RS row, work to last 6 sts, k3tog, k2, selvage st.

**Full-fashion increase**: On RS row: M1R, 4 sts in from each edge.

**Gauge**: 14 sts and 20 rows =  $10 \times 10 \text{ cm}$  in St st on size 8 mm needles.

**Back**: With size 6 mm needles cast on 87 (93, 99) sts. Next row (WS): Two-stitch selvage, \* k1, p1; rep from \* to last 3 sts, k1, two-stitch selvage. Cont in rib patt as set by last row until piece meas 6 cm from cast-on, ending with a WS row. Change to size 8 mm needles. Maintaining two-stitch selvage, work in St st until piece meas 43 cm from cast-on, ending with a WS row. Shape armholes: Next row (RS): Two-stitch selvage; 9 sts in rib patt = [p1, k1] 4 times, p1; M1R, work in St st to last 11 sts, M1R; 9 sts in rib patt = [p1, k1] 4 times, p1; two-stitch selvage. Cont in patt as set by last row, rep incs every 6th row 5 times = 99 (105, 111) sts. Work increased sts in St st. Maintaining two-stitch selvage and 9 sts in rib patt at each edge, work even in St st until armhole meas 23 (24, 25)

cm, ending with a WS row. Shape shoulders and neck: At each shoulder edge bind off 6 (6, 7) sts 1 time, then 6 sts 4 times, 7 sts 1 time (then 6 sts 1 time, 7 sts 4 times / then 7 sts 4 times, 8 sts 1 time). At same time, when piece meas 4 cm from beg of shoulder shaping, shape neck as foll: Next row (RS): Bind off center 21 sts. Working each side separately, bind off 2 sts at each neck edge 1 time. No sts rem.

**Front**: Work same as back until piece meas 49 (50, 51) cm from cast-on, ending with a WS row. Divide work at center for zipper placket: Next row (RS): Bind off center st. Working each side separately and working a selvage st at each placket edge, cont until piece meas 16 cm from divide, ending with a WS row. Shape neck: Working full-fashion dbl dec, dec 2 st at each neck edge every RS row 6 times and when same length as back to shoulders, shape shoulders same as for back. No sts rem.

**Sleeves**: With size 6 mm needles cast on 39 sts. Next row (WS): Two-stitch selvage, \* k1, p1; rep from \* to last 3 sts, k1, two-stitch selvage. Cont in rib patt as set by last row until piece meas 7 cm from cast-on, ending with a WS row. Change to size 8 mm needles. Maintaining two-stitch selvage, work in St st and shape sleeve as foll: Working full-fashion inc, inc 1 st at each end of first row, then every 6th row 3 times, then every 4th row 10 times (then every 6th row 1 time, then every 4th row 13 times / then every 4th row 14 times, then every alt row 1 time) = 67 (69, 71) sts. Work even until piece meas 37 cm from cast-on, ending with a WS row. Maintaining two-stitch selvage, work in rib patt for 5 cm. Loosely bind off all sts in rib.

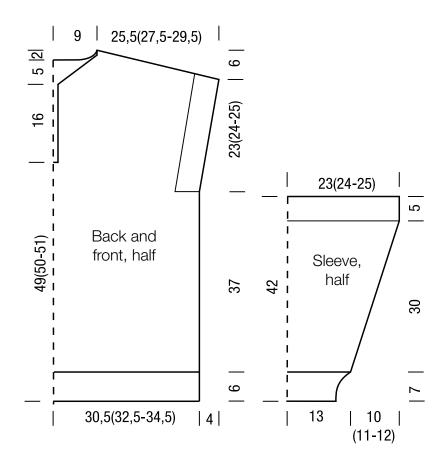
**Collar**: With size 6 mm needles cast on 65 sts. Next row (WS): Selvage st, \* p1, k1; rep from \* to last 2 sts, p1, selvage st. Cont in rib patt as set by last row until piece meas 24 cm from cast-on, ending with a WS row. Next row (RS): Bind off center 55 sts = 5 sts rem each side. Working each side separately and maintaining selvage sts, work in St st for 20 cm. Bind off all sts.

**Finishing**: Pin pieces to measurements and block. Sew shoulder seams. Sew cast-on edge of collar to neck, easing to fit. Fold collar in half to WS and sew down. Sew in zipper along placket and collar. Sew zipper facing in place on WS. Sew on sleeves. Sew side and sleeve seams. NOTE: Sew all seams 1 st in from each edge.

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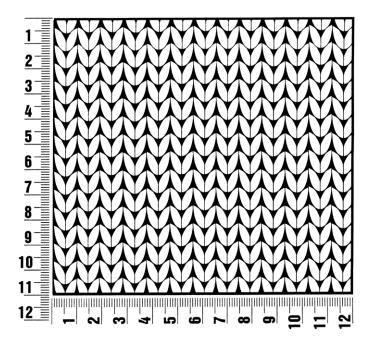


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### Gauge Swatch

#### Before you begin ...

...make a gauge swatch. Use the recommended needles, yarns and pattern stitch for your gauge swatch. It should measure approx. 12 cm x 12 cm. Cast-on and bind-off rows, as well as selvage stitches should not be included in the measurement. Pin your swatch and block it as you would the finished pieces of the garment. Count stitches and rows over 10 cm. If your gauge swatch is too small, switch to larger needles. If your gauge swatch is too big, switch to smaller needles.

**beg** = begin(ning)  $\cdot$  **ch** = chain  $\cdot$  **cont** = continue  $\cdot$  **dec** = decreas(e)(ing)  $\cdot$  **inc** = increas(e)(ing)  $\cdot$  **k** = knit  $\cdot$  **kwise** = as if to knit **meas** = measures  $\cdot$  **M1L** = lift strand between sts from front to back and knit this strand through the back loop  $\cdot$  **M1R** = lift strand between sts from the back and knit this strand through the front loop  $\cdot$  **patt** = pattern  $\cdot$  **pm** = place marker  $\cdot$  **p** = purl **pwise** = as if to purl  $\cdot$  **rem** = remain(ing)  $\cdot$  **rep** = repeat(s)  $\cdot$  **rev St st** = reverse stockinette stitch  $\cdot$  **rnd(s)** = round(s)  $\cdot$  **RS** = right side  $\cdot$  **sc** = single crochet  $\cdot$  **skp** = slip 1 stitch as if to knit, knit 1 stitch, pass slipped stitch over knitted stitch  $\cdot$  **sk2p** = slip 1 stitch as if to knit, knit 2 together, pass slipped stitch over knitted stitch  $\cdot$  **s2kp** = slip 2 stitches as if to knit, k 1 stitch, pass slipped stitches over knitted stitch  $\cdot$  **s1** = slip  $\cdot$  **st(s)** = stitch(es)  $\cdot$  **St st** = stockinette stitch  $\cdot$  **tbl** = through the back loop  $\cdot$  **tog** = together  $\cdot$  **wyib** = with yarn in back of work  $\cdot$  **wyif** = with yarn in front of work  $\cdot$  **WS** = wrong side  $\cdot$  **yo(s)** = yarn over(s)
