PULLOVER

Size 36/38 (40/42, 44) Instructions are given for first size. Figures in parenthesis refer to larger sizes. When only one figure is given, it applies to all sizes.

Materials: 350 (400, 450) g of Lana Grossa Alta Moda Cotolana (45% Merino wool, 45% Pima cotton, 10% polyamide; 150 m/50 g) in Light Beige (col 19) and 150 (150, 200) g in Midnight Blue (col 29). Size 4 mm needles; size 4 mm circular needle, 40 cm long.

Rib patt: K1, p1.

St st: K on RS, p on WS.

Stripe patt: Work 6 rows in Midnight Blue, 12 rows in Light Beige alternately throughout.

Selvage sts: On RS row, ktbl first st, sl last st pwise wyib. On WS row, ptbl first st, sl last st pwise wyif.

Full-fashion increase: On RS row: M1R, 2 sts in from each edge.

Gauge: 20 sts and 29 rows = 10×10 cm in St st on size 4 mm needles.

Back: With size 4 mm needles and Light Beige cast on 131 (139, 147) sts. Next row (WS): Selvage st, * k1, p1; rep from * to last 2 sts, k1, selvage st. Work in rib patt as set by last row until piece meas 13 cm from cast-on, ending with a WS row. Maintaining selvage sts, work in St st for 6 rows, decreasing 1 st at center of first row = 130 (138, 146) sts. Cont in St st and work stripe patt until piece meas 38 cm from cast-on. Place marker in first and last st on last WS row to indicate beg of armholes. Cont until stripe patt has been worked a total of 5 times. Work next 6 rows in Midnight Blue, then cont in Light Beige only until piece meas 58 (59, 60) cm from cast-on, ending with a WS row. Shape shoulders and neck: At each shoulder edge bind off 5 sts 8 times, 6 sts 1 time (5 sts 4 times, 6 sts 5 times / 6 sts 9 times). At same time, when piece meas 4 cm from beg of shoulder shaping, shape neck as foll: Next row (RS): Bind off center 28 sts. Working each side separately, bind off 3 sts at each neck edge 1 time, 2 sts 1 time. No sts rem.


Front: Work same as back until piece meas 56 (57, 58) cm from cast-on, ending with a WS row. Shape neck: Next row (RS): Bind off center 14 sts. Working each side separately, bind off 4 sts at each neck edge 1 time, 2 sts 1 time, 1 st 6 times and when same length as back to shoulders, shape shoulders same as for back. No sts rem.

Sleeves: Note: Cuffs are worked separately and side to side. With size 4 mm needles and Light Beige cast on 66 sts for sleeve. Beg with a WS row and working first and last st as selvage sts, work in St st for 7 rows. Cont in St st and work stripe patt until piece meas 11 cm from cast-on, ending with a WS row. Shape sleeve: Working full-fashion inc, inc 1 st at each end of next RS row, then every 10th row 2 times, then every 8th row 5 times

(then every alt 6th and 8th row 9 times / then every 6th row 10 times, then every 4th row 1 time) = 82 (86, 90) sts. Work even until stripe patt has been worked a total of 5 times and piece meas 34 cm from cast-on. Bind off all sts.

Cuffs: With size 4 mm needles and Light Beige cast on 28 sts. Beg with a WS row and working first and last st as selvage sts, work in St st for 7 rows. Cont in St st and work stripe patt 4 times. Work 6 more rows in Midnight Blue, 6 more rows in Light Beige. Bind off all sts.

Finishing: Pin pieces to measurements and block. Sew shoulder seams. Neckband: With size 4 mm circular needle, pick up and k 90 sts evenly around neck edge. Place beg of rnd marker and join for working in rnds. Purl 1 rnd. Work rib patt in rnds until band meas 2.5 cm from pick-up rnd. Bind off all sts in rib. With mattress st and from WS (so seam forms a ridge on the RS), sew cuffs to cast-on edge of sleeves. With mattress st and from WS (so seam forms a ridge on the RS), sew on sleeves between markers. Sew side and sleeve seams, leaving bottom 13 cm of side seams open for split hem [see * on schematic].

GAUGE SWATCH

Before you begin knitting...

...make a gauge swatch. Use the recommended needles, yarns and pattern stitch for your gauge swatch. It should measure approx. 12 cm x 12 cm. Cast on and bind off rows, as well as selvage stitches should not be included in the measurement. Pin your swatch and block it as you would the finished pieces of the garment. Count stitches and rows over 10 cm. If your gauge swatch is too small, switch to larger needles. If your gauge swatch is too big, switch to smaller needles.
