Design 21 – Linea Pura 16

PULLOVER NASTRINO



Size One size.

Materials: 250 g of Lana Grossa **Nastrino** (100% cotton; 190 m/50 g) in Terracotta **(col 12)**. Size 2.5, 3 and 4 mm needles; size 2.5 mm circular needle, 60 cm long.

Selvage stitches: On every row: SI first st kwise, k last st.

Rib patt: K1, p1.

St st: K on RS, p on WS.

Rib and eyelet patt: Work according to chart. Multiple of 3 + 1 + 2 selvage sts. Numbers at left edge of chart indicate WS rows, numbers at right edge of chart indicate RS rows. Chart begins with a WS row. Work to patt rep, work sts between arrows for patt rep, work to end of chart. Rep rows 1 - 8.

Full-fashion decrease: <u>At beg of RS row</u>, selvage st, patt over 3 sts, skp; <u>at end of RS row</u>, work to last 6 sts, k2tog, patt over 3 sts, selvage st. <u>Note</u>: On foll WS rows, p4 after selvage st and before selvage st.

Full-fashion increase: <u>On RS row</u>: M1R, 1 st in from each edge.

Gauges: 23.5 sts and 30 rows = 10×10 cm in St st on size 4 mm needles; 23.5 sts and 32 rows = 10×7 cm in rib and eyelet patt on size 3 mm needles.


Back: With size 2.5 mm needles cast on 105 sts. Beg with a WS row and end with a RS row and working first and last st as selvage sts, work in rib patt for 38 rows and piece meas 6 cm from cast-on. Change to size 4 mm needles. Maintaining selvage sts, work in St st for 30 rows = 8 cm, ending with a RS row. Change to size 3 mm needles. Work chart for 32 rows = 7 cm. Change to size 4 mm needles. Work in St st for 26 rows = 7 cm. Change to size 3 mm needles. Work chart for 32 rows = 7 cm. Change to size 4 mm needles. Work in St st for 30 rows = 8 cm. At same time, on 14th row of 2nd rib and evelet patt section, beg raglan shaping as foll: Bind off 5 sts at beg of next 2 rows. Working full-fashion dec, dec 1 st at each end of next 11 RS rows, then every alt RS row 6 times = 61 sts. Note: When working shaping in rib and eyelet patt, make sure each yo is paired with a decrease or vice versa. Work 2 rows even and piece meas 12 cm from beg of raglan shaping. Place rem 61 sts on holder.

Front: Work same as back.

Sleeves: With size 2.5 mm needles cast on 55 sts. Beg with a WS row and end with a RS row and working first and last st as selvage sts, work in rib patt for 58 rows and piece meas 9 cm from cast-on. Change to size 4 mm needles. Maintaining selvage sts, work in St st and rib and eyelet patt same as for

back and <u>at same time</u>, shape sleeve as foll: Working full-fashion inc, inc 1 st at each end of 10th row from end of rib patt, then every 12th row 7 times = 71 sts. Cont in patt and <u>at same time</u>, on 14th row of 2nd rib and eyelet patt section work cap shaping same as for back raglan. Place rem 27 sts on holder.

Finishing: Pin pieces to measurements and block. Sew raglan, side and sleeve seams. <u>Collar</u>: Return 61 held back sts, 27 held sleeve sts, 61 held front sts and 27 held sleeve sts to size 2.5 mm circular needle = 176 sts and with RS facing rejoin yarn. Place beg of rnd marker and join for working in rnds. Work in rib patt for 9 cm. Bind off all sts in rib.






Gauge Swatch

Before you begin ...

...make a gauge swatch. Use the recommended needles, yarns and pattern stitch for your gauge swatch. It should measure approx. 12 cm x 12 cm. Cast-on and bind-off rows, as well as selvage stitches should not be included in the measurement. Pin your swatch and block it as you would the finished pieces of the garment. Count stitches and rows over 10 cm. If your gauge swatch is too small, switch to larger needles. If your gauge swatch is too big, switch to smaller needles.

beg = begin(ning) \cdot **ch** = chain \cdot **cont** = continue \cdot **dec** = decreas(e)(ing) \cdot **inc** = increas(e)(ing) \cdot **k** = knit \cdot **kwise** = as if to knit **meas** = measures \cdot **M1L** = lift strand between sts from front to back and knit this strand through the back loop \cdot **M1R** = lift strand between sts from the back and knit this strand through the front loop \cdot **patt** = pattern \cdot **pm** = place marker \cdot **p** = purl **pwise** = as if to purl \cdot **rem** = remain(ing) \cdot **rep** = repeat(s) \cdot **rev** St st = reverse stockinette stitch \cdot **rnd(s)** = round(s) \cdot **RS** = right side \cdot **sc** = single crochet \cdot **skp** = slip 1 stitch as if to knit, knit 1 stitch, pass slipped stitch over knitted stitch \cdot **sk2p** = slip 1 stitch as if to knit, knit 2 together, pass slipped stitch over knitted stitch \cdot **s2kp** = slip 2 stitches as if to knit, k 1 stitch, pass slipped stitches over knitted stitch \cdot **sl** = slip \cdot **st(s)** = stitch(es) \cdot St st = stockinette stitch \cdot **tbl** = through the back loop \cdot **tog** = together \cdot **wyib** = with yarn in back of work \cdot **wyif** = with yarn in front of work \cdot **WS** = wrong side \cdot **yo(s)** = yarn over(s)
